

# Isaiah 34 - The Day of the Lord: Armageddon; The Judgment of the Nations

Judgment has been the theme all the way through this section. We have looked at six woes and followed a progression in this prophecy. We saw a local situation into which Isaiah spoke and then watched him move into that broader area, as he looked down through the centuries to the time of judgment that was coming in the future, which the Lord Jesus called the Great Tribulation.

There's no doubt about it. This passage directed toward the people on Earth at the End of the Age. Remember, the Lord had Jeremiah write that one of His objectives in the Great Tribulation was to completely destroy the nations (Jer 30:11). Depending on whose interpretation you favor, up to half the world's post rapture population will perish during the 7 years of Daniel's 70th week. The worst case scenario calls for an average of over 1 million deaths each day for 7 years as the most devastating time in Earth's history takes its grizzly toll. To say that chapter 34 is an intense passage would be to make one of the great understatements of all time. Even the Revelation will be hard pressed to surpass it.

## Isaiah 34

### (C) Tribulation and Kingdom (Is 34:1—35:10)

#### (a) Tribulation (34:1-17)

##### (i) Judgment on all nations (34:1-4)

**1** Come near, **you nations**, to hear; and listen, you peoples! Let the earth and all it contains hear, and the world and all that springs from it.

- "...you nations" - shift of emphasis to the nations, not Jerusalem or Israel, and not their specific immediate enemies

- "...anger" - wrath of God; documented in Rev 19:19 through Rev 21; Zech 14

— These are the strongest possible expressions that could be used. The judgment is universal, and it is severe.

— Our Lord spoke of this as a time of suffering that will be unparalleled in the history of the world

(ii) Judgment on Edom whose lust for Israel's land epitomizes the sin of all nations (34:5-17)

- At the Second Coming, Jesus will first visit the Remnant in *Bozrah* (Is 63:1-6; Hab 3:3; Micah 2:12-13; Judges 5:4-5), and protect them from the Antichrist's army coming to kill them

-- This verse indicates that the slaughter will take place in Edom, specifically in *Bozrah* (v6)

- From Esau, twin of Jacob. Obadiah 3 attributes sin of pride to Edom (Jer 49:16)
- Esau to serve Jacob (Gen 25:23; 27:40)
- Rejoiced under Nebuchadnezzar's captivity (Ps 137:7; Obadiah 10-14; Lam 4:21-22; Ezek 35:10-13)
- Edom: Possession for Judah (Num 24:18)
- Cursed in Amos 1:11-12; Mal 1:3-4

The Judgment against Edom is mentioned in more OT books than it is against any other foreign nation: Is 11:14; 34:5-17; 63:1-6; Jer 9:25-26; 25:17-26; 49:7-22; Lam 4:21-22; Ezek 25:12-14; 35:15; Joel 3:19; Amos 1:11-12; 9:11-12; Obadiah 1-21; Mal 1:4

- Similar to Babylon; the two locations that will be desolate and uninhabited during the Messianic Kingdom. Both locations will burn with pitch and brimstone for eternity.

— Like Babylon, Edom will be an abode for demons

- "...night-bird" - *tyliyl*, "lileth" which also means female demon. These idioms are not zoological but demonic in vocabulary (see notes on Is 13:20-22; Jer 50:39-40; Rev 18:1-2).
