At the time of the setting up of the Kingdom, there may be some feeling among the Gentiles that, because of the exalted position of Israel, the Gentiles will be excluded from receiving the benefits of Millennial Temple worship (v1-3). But this will not be the case, for the Temple ministry will be open to all Gentiles who are rightly related to the King. Under no circumstances will they be excluded either because they are Gentiles or because they are mutilated (v4-5). It is then and only then that the House of God will be called truly a house of prayer for all nations (v6-7). When will that be? At the time of Israel's final regathering (v8).

Isaiah 56

(F) Deliverance of the Gentiles (56:1-12)

(a) Israel exhorted to follow God's covenant (56:1-2)

1 This is what the LORD says: "Guard justice and do righteousness, For My salvation is about to come And My righteousness to be revealed.

1 Thus says the LORD, "Preserve justice and do righteousness, For My salvation is about to come And My righteousness to be revealed.

1 For this is what the LORD says: "Maintain justice, and do what is right, for soon my salvation will come, and soon my deliverance will be revealed.

1 Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

(b) Gentiles exhorted to follow God's covenant (56:3-8)

3 Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to the LORD say, "The LORD will certainly separate me from His people." Nor let the eunuch say, "Behold, I am a dry tree."

- During the Kingdom, Gentiles who are rightly related to the King will be welcomed to the Temple for worship, and will not be excluded from receiving the benefits of Temple worship

- Under no circumstances will Gentiles in right standing before the King be excluded, even if they are mutilated

- After Gentile inclusion in worship is when the House of God will truly be called a house of prayer for all nations

— Gentile worship in the Millennial Temple is also taught in Is 66:18-24

- "...a house of prayer" - Jesus quoted this verse when He cleared the moneychangers from the Temple a second time (Matt 21:13)

(c) Rebuke to those who refuse to hold to God's covenant (56:9-12)
