

# Verses on Faith Alone

There are approximately 160 verses in the NT that clearly state that salvation is solely based upon a person's faith, trust, or belief in Jesus Christ as Savior. I've listed 134 below and will add to the list as time goes on.

Luke 7:48-50:

48 And He said to her, **"Your sins have been forgiven."**

49 And *then* those who were reclining *at the table* with Him began saying to themselves, "Who is this *man* who even forgives sins?"

50 And He said to the woman, **"Your faith has saved you; go in peace."**

Luke 8:12: **And those beside the road are the ones who have heard, then the devil comes and takes away the word from their heart, so that they will not believe and be saved.**

Luke 18:42: And Jesus said to him, **"Regain your sight; your faith has made you well."**

John 1:7: He came as a witness, to testify about the Light, **so that all might believe through him.**

John 1:12: But **as many as received Him**, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who **believe in His name**,

John 2:23: Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many **believed in His name** as they observed His signs which He was doing.

John 3:15: **so that everyone who believes** will have eternal life in Him.

John 3:16: **"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him** will not perish, but have eternal life.

John 3:18: **The one who believes** in Him is not judged; the one who does not believe has been judged already, because he **has not believed** in the name of the only Son of God.

John 3:36: The one who **believes** in the Son has eternal life; but the one who **does not obey the Son** will not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him."

John 4:39: Now from that city many of the Samaritans **believed** in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all the things that I have done."

John 4:41-42:

41 Many more **believed** because of His word;

42 and they were saying to the woman, "*It is no longer because of what you said that we **believe**, for we have heard for ourselves and know that this One truly is the Savior of the world.*"

John 5:24: "*Truly, truly, I say to you, the one who hears My word, and **believes** Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.*"

John 5:45-47:

45 *Do not think that I will accuse you before the Father; the one who accuses you is Moses, in whom you have put your hope.*

46 *For if you **believed** Moses, you would **believe** Me; for he wrote about Me.*

47 *But if you do not **believe** his writings, how will you **believe** My words?"*

John 6:29: Jesus answered and said to them, "*This is the work of God, that you **believe** in Him whom He has sent.*"

John 6:35: Jesus said to them, "*I am the bread of life; the one who comes to Me will not be hungry, and the one who **believes** in Me will never be thirsty.*"

John 6:40: *For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who sees the Son and **believes** in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day.*"

John 6:47: *Truly, truly, I say to you, the one who **believes** has eternal life.*

John 7:38: *The one who **believes** in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'*"

John 7:39: But this He said in reference to the Spirit, whom those who **believed** in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

John 8:24: Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you **believe** that I am, you will die in your sins."

John 8:30: As He said these things, many came to **believe** in Him.

John 9:35-38:

35 Jesus heard that they had put him out, and upon finding him, He said, "Do you **believe** in the Son of Man?"

36 He answered by saying, "And who is He, Sir, that I may **believe** in Him?"

37 Jesus said to him, "You have both seen Him, and He is the one who is talking with you."

38 And he said, "I **believe**, Lord." And he worshiped Him.

John 10:24-26:

24 The Jews then surrounded Him and *began* saying to Him, "How long will You keep us in suspense? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly."

25 Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not **believe**; the works that I do in My Father's name, these testify of Me.

26 But you do not **believe**, because you are not of My sheep.

John 11:15: and I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, so that you may **believe**; but let's go to him."

John 11:25: Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; the one who **believes** in Me will live, even if he dies,

John 11:26: and everyone who lives and **believes** in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"

John 11:42: But I knew that You always hear Me; nevertheless, because of the people standing around I said *it*, so that they may **believe** that You sent Me."

John 12:36: While you have the Light, **believe** in the Light, so that you may become sons of Light." These things Jesus proclaimed, and He went away and hid Himself from them.

John 12:46: I have come as Light into the world, so that no one who **believes** in Me will remain in darkness.

John 13:19: From now on I am telling you before *it* happens, so that when it does happen, you may **believe** that I am *He*.

John 14:1: "Do not let your heart be troubled; **believe** in God, **believe** also in Me.

John 17:20: "I am not asking on behalf of these alone, but also for those who **believe** in Me through their word,

John 17:21: that they may all be one; just as You, Father, *are* in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may **believe** that You sent Me.

John 19:35: And he who has seen has testified, and his testimony is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you also may **believe**.

John 20:29: Jesus \*said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you *now* **believed**? Blessed *are* they who did not see, and yet **believed**."

John 20:31: but these have been written so that you may **believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that by **believing** you may have life in His name.

Acts 3:16: And on the basis of faith in His name, *it is* the name of Jesus which has strengthened this man whom you see and know; and **the faith which comes through Him** has given him this perfect health in the presence of you all.

Acts 4:4: But many of those who had heard the message **believed**; and the number of the **men** came to be about five thousand.

Acts 4:32: And the congregation of those who **believed** were of one heart and soul; and not one of *them* claimed that anything belonging to him was his own, but all things were common property to them.

Acts 8:12: But when they **believed** Philip as he was preaching the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were being baptized.

Acts 8:37: [And Philip said, "If you **believe** with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I **believe** that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."]

Acts 9:42: It became known all over Joppa, and many **believed** in the Lord.

Acts 10:43: All the prophets testify of Him, that through His name everyone who **believes** in Him receives forgiveness of sins."

Acts 11:17: Therefore, if God gave them the same gift as *He* also *gave* to us after **believing** in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?"

Acts 11:21: And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a large number who **believed** turned to the Lord.

Acts 13:39: and through Him everyone who **believes** is freed from all things, from which you could not be freed through the Law of Moses.

Acts 14:1: In Iconium they entered the synagogue of the Jews together, and spoke in such a way that a large number of people **believed**, both of Jews and of Greeks.

Acts 14:23: When they had appointed elders for them in every church, having prayed with fasting, they entrusted them to the Lord in whom they had **believed**.

Acts 14:27: When they had arrived and gathered the church together, they *began* to report all the things that God had done with them and how He had opened a door of **faith** to the Gentiles.

Acts 15:7: After there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brothers, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles would hear the word of the gospel and **believe**.

Acts 15:9: and He made no distinction between us and them, cleansing their hearts **by faith**.

Acts 16:31: They said, "**Believe** in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."

Acts 17:12: Therefore, many of them **believed**, along with a significant number of prominent Greek women and men.

Acts 18:8: Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, **believed** in the Lord together with his entire household; and many of the Corinthians, as they listened to *Paul*, were **believing** and

being baptized.

Acts 18:27: And when he wanted to go across to Achaia, the brothers encouraged him and wrote to the disciples to welcome him; and when he had arrived, he greatly helped those who had **believed** through grace,

Acts 19:4: Paul said, "John baptized with a baptism of repentance, telling the people to **believe** in Him who was coming after him, that is, in Jesus."

Acts 20:21: solemnly testifying to both Jews and Greeks of repentance toward God and **faith** in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Acts 21:25: But regarding the Gentiles who have **believed**, we sent a letter, having decided that they should abstain from meat sacrificed to idols and from blood and what is strangled, and from sexual immorality."

Acts 26:18: **to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'**

Rom 1:16: For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who **believes**, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Rom 3:22: but *it is the* righteousness of God **through faith in Jesus Christ** for all those who **believe**; for there is no distinction,

Rom 3:25: whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through **faith**. *This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in God's merciful restraint He let the sins previously committed go unpunished;*

Rom 3:26: for the demonstration, *that is*, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has **faith in Jesus**.

Rom 3:27: Where then is boasting? It has been excluded. By what kind of law? Of works? No, but by a law of **faith**.

Rom 3:28: For we maintain that a person is justified by **faith** apart from works of the Law.

Rom 3:30: since indeed God who will justify the circumcised by **faith** and the uncircumcised through faith is one.

Rom 4:3: For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM **BELIEVED** GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."

Rom 4:5: But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his **faith** is credited as righteousness,

Rom 4:9: Is this blessing then on the circumcised, or on the uncircumcised also? For we say, "**FAITH** WAS CREDITED TO ABRAHAM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."

Rom 4:11: and he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the **faith** which he had while uncircumcised, so that he might be the father of all who believe without being circumcised, that righteousness might be credited to them,

Rom 4:13: For the promise to Abraham or to his descendants that he would be heir of the world was not through the Law, but through the righteousness of **faith**.

Rom 4:16: For this reason *it is* by **faith**, in order that *it may be* in accordance with grace, so that the promise will be guaranteed to all the descendants, not only to those who are of the Law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all,

Rom 4:23-24:

23 Now not for his sake only was it written that it was credited to him,

24 but for our sake also, to whom it will be credited, to *us* who believe in Him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead,

Rom 5:1: Therefore, having been justified by **faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

Rom 5:2: through whom we also have obtained our introduction by **faith** into this grace in which we stand; and we celebrate in hope of the glory of God.

Rom 9:30: What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, attained righteousness, but the righteousness that is by **faith**;

Rom 9:32: Why? Because they did not pursue it by **faith**, but as though they could by works. They stumbled over the stumbling stone,

Rom 9:33: just as it is written: "BEHOLD, I AM LAYING IN ZION A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE, AND THE ONE WHO **BELIEVES** IN HIM WILL NOT BE PUT TO SHAME."

Rom 10:4: For Christ is the end of the Law for righteousness to everyone who **believes**.

Rom 10:6: But the righteousness based on **faith** speaks as follows: "DO NOT SAY IN YOUR HEART, 'WHO WILL GO UP INTO HEAVEN?' (that is, to bring Christ down),

Rom 10:9: that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and **believe** in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

Rom 10:10: for with the heart *a person* **believes**, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

Rom 11:20: Quite right, they were broken off for their **unbelief**, but you stand by your **faith**. Do not be conceited, but fear;

Rom 15:13: Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in **believing**, so that you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

1 Cor 1:21: For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not *come to* know God, God was pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who **believe**.

2 Cor 4:4: in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the **unbelieving** so that they will not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

Gal 2:16: nevertheless, knowing that a person is not justified by works of the Law but through **faith** in Christ Jesus, even we have **believed** in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by **faith** in Christ and not by works of the Law; since by works of the Law no flesh will be justified.



Gal 2:20: I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by **faith** in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Gal 3:2: This is the only thing I want to find out from you: did you receive the Spirit by works of the Law, or by hearing with **faith**?

Gal 3:5: So then, does He who provides you with the Spirit and works miracles among you, do it by works of the Law, or by hearing with **faith**?

Gal 3:6: Just as Abraham **BELIEVED** GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Gal 3:7: Therefore, recognize that it is those who are of **faith** who are sons of Abraham.

Gal 3:8: The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by **faith**, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, *saying*, "ALL THE NATIONS WILL BE BLESSED IN YOU."

Gal 3:9: So then, those who are of **faith** are blessed with Abraham, the believer.

Gal 3:11: Now, that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, "THE RIGHTEOUS ONE WILL LIVE BY **FAITH**."

Gal 3:14: in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham would come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through **faith**.

Gal 3:22: But the Scripture has confined everyone under sin, so that the promise by **faith** in Jesus Christ might be given to those who **believe**.

Gal 3:24: Therefore the Law has become our guardian *to lead us* to Christ, so that we may be justified by **faith**.

Gal 3:26: For you are all sons *and daughters* of God through **faith** in Christ Jesus.

Gal 5:5: For we, through the Spirit, by **faith**, are waiting for the hope of righteousness.

Eph 1:13: In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also **believed**, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of the promise,

Eph 1:19: and what is the boundless greatness of His power toward us who **believe**. *These are* in accordance with the working of the strength of His might

Eph 2:8: For by grace you have been saved through **faith**; and **this** *is* not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God;

Eph 3:17: so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through **faith**; *and* that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

Phil 1:29: For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to **believe** in Him, but also to suffer on His behalf,

Phil 3:9: and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from *the* Law, but that which is through **faith** in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of **faith**,

1 Thess 1:7: so that you became an example to all the **believers** in Macedonia and Achaia.

1 Thess 2:10: You are witnesses, and *so is* God, *of* how devoutly and rightly and blamelessly we behaved toward you **believers**;

1 Thess 4:14: For if we **believe** that Jesus died and rose *from the dead*, so also God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep through Jesus.

2 Thess 1:10: when He comes to be glorified among His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have **believed**—because our testimony to you was **believed**.

2 Thess 2:12-13:

12 in order that they all may be judged who **did not believe the truth**, but took pleasure in wickedness.

**13** But we should always give thanks to God for you, brothers *and sisters* beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.

2 Thess 3:2: and that we will be rescued from troublesome and evil people; for not all have the **faith**.

1 Tim 1:16: Yet for this reason I found mercy, so that in me as the foremost *sinner* Jesus Christ might demonstrate His perfect patience as an example for those who would **believe** in Him for eternal life.

1 Tim 3:16: Beyond question, great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, **Believed** on in the world, Taken up in glory.

1 Tim 4:3: who forbid marriage *and advocate* abstaining from foods which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who **believe** and know the truth.

1 Tim 4:10: For it is for this we labor and strive, because we have set our hope on the living God, who is the Savior of all mankind, especially of **believers**.

2 Tim 1:12: 1For this reason I also suffer these things; but I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have **believed**, and I am convinced that He is able to protect what I have entrusted to Him until that day.

2 Tim 3:15: and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to **salvation through faith** which is in Christ Jesus.

Heb 4:2: For indeed we have had good news preached to us, just as they also *did*; but the word they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united with those who listened with **faith**.

Heb 4:3: For we who have **believed** enter *that* rest, just as He has said, "AS I SWORE IN MY ANGER, THEY CERTAINLY SHALL NOT ENTER MY REST," although His works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Heb 6:12: so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through **faith** and endurance inherit the promises.

Heb 10:39: But we are not among those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have **faith** for the safekeeping of the soul.

Heb 11:6: And without **faith** it is impossible to please *Him*, for the one who comes to God must **believe** that He exists, and *that* He proves to be One who rewards those who seek Him.

Heb 11:7: By faith Noah, being warned *by God* about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world, and became an heir of the righteousness which is according to **faith**.

James 2:23: and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "AND ABRAHAM **BELIEVED** GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS," and he was called a friend of God.

1 Peter 1:21: who through Him are **believers** in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your **faith** and hope are in God.

1 Peter 2:6: For *this* is contained in Scripture: "BEHOLD, I AM LAYING IN ZION A CHOICE STONE, A PRECIOUS CORNERSTONE, AND THE ONE WHO **BELIEVES** IN HIM WILL NOT BE PUT TO SHAME."

1 Peter 2:7: This precious value, then, is for you who **believe**; but for unbelievers, "A STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, THIS BECAME THE CHIEF CORNERSTONE,"

1 John 5:1: Everyone who **believes** that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves the *child* born of Him.

1 John 5:5: Who is the one who overcomes the world, but the one who **believes** that Jesus is the Son of God?

1 John 5:10: The one who **believes** in the Son of God has the testimony in himself; the one who does not **believe** God has made Him a liar, because he has not **believed** in the testimony that God has given concerning His Son.

1 John 5:13: These things I have written to you who **believe** in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.

Jude 5: Now I want to remind you, though you know everything once *and* for all, that the Lord, after saving a people out of the land of Egypt, subsequently destroyed those who did not **believe**.
