Psalm 17

[A Prayer of David.]

A Cry for Justice

1 Hear a just cause, LORD, give *Your* attention to my cry; Listen to my prayer, which is not from deceitful lips.

1 Hear a just cause, O LORD, give heed to my cry; Give ear to my prayer, which is not from deceitful lips.

1 LORD, hear my just plea! Pay attention to my cry! Listen to my prayer, since it does not come from lying lips.

1 Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, that goeth not out of feigned lips.

2 Let my judgment come forth from Your presence; Let Your eyes look with integrity.

2 Let my judgment come forth from Your presence; Let Your eyes look with equity.

2 Justice for me will come from your presence; your eyes see what is right.

2 Let my sentence come forth from thy presence; let thine eyes behold the things that are equal.

3 You have put my heart to the test; You have visited *me* by night; You have sifted me and You find nothing; My intent is that my mouth will not offend.

5 Because my steps have held fast to your paths, my footsteps have not faltered.

5 Hold up my goings in thy paths, that my footsteps slip not.

7 Show forth your gracious love, save those who take refuge in you from those who rebel against your sovereign power.

7 Shew thy marvellous lovingkindness, O thou that savest by thy right hand them which put their trust in thee from those that rise up against them.
