

Psalm 089 - Messianic Psalm: The Davidic Covenant

Psalm 89

[Maschil of Ethan the Ezrahite.]

God's Covenant with David

1 I will sing of the graciousness of the LORD forever; To all generations I will make Your faithfulness known with my mouth.

1 I will sing of the lovingkindness of the LORD forever; To all generations I will make known Your faithfulness with my mouth.

1 I will sing forever about the gracious love of the LORD; from generation to generation I will declare your faithfulness with my mouth.

1 I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.

2 For I have said, "Graciousness will be built up forever; In the heavens You will establish Your faithfulness."

God's Describes His Anointed

— All the references in this psalm, regardless of the pronoun used, refer to the faithfulness of God

- The Covenant is not dependent upon David or upon his descendants, but upon God's character. Since God does not lie, the covenant is sure to stand. For this very reason, the eternity of the Davidic Dynasty and Throne are assured (Cf. Is 9:7).

- David will have a Son who will sit on the throne of this universe. That fact is as established as the moon is established in the heavens, and it looks like the moon is going to be there for a long time.

A Commitment to Persevere

- Verses 39-45 describe the invasion of Shishak, which occurred in Rehoboam's reign (1 Chr 12)

— Jeremiah had announced a blood curse on Jehoiachin (also called Jeconiah, or Coniah)
