

Psalm 094 - Enthronement Psalm: A Call Upon God to Intervene Against the Wicked

Psalm 94

God Avengers His Own

- 1 LORD, God of vengeance, God of vengeance, shine forth!
- 1 O LORD, God of vengeance, God of vengeance, shine forth!
- 1 God of vengeance, LORD God of vengeance, display your splendor!
- 1 O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, shew thyself.

- 2 Rise up, Judge of the earth, Pay back retribution to the proud.
- 2 Rise up, O Judge of the earth, Render recompense to the proud.
- 2 Stand up, judge of the earth, and repay the proud.
- 2 Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud.

8 Pay attention, you dull ones among the crowds! You fools! Will you ever become wise?
8 Understand, ye brutish among the people: and ye fools, when will ye be wise?
- "...stupid" - beastly, lacking values and discernment, savage, living only to satisfy the appetite

9 He who planted the ear, does He not hear? Or He who formed the eye, does He not see?

9 The one who formed the ear can hear, can he not? The one who made the eyes can see, can he not?
9 He that planted the ear, shall he not hear? he that formed the eye, shall he not see?

10 He who disciplines the nations, will He not rebuke, He who teaches mankind knowledge?
10 He who chastens the nations, will He not rebuke, *Even* He who teaches man knowledge?
10 The one who disciplines nations can rebuke them, can he not? The one who teaches mankind can discern, can he not?
10 He that chastiseth the heathen, shall not he correct? he that teacheth man knowledge, shall not he know?

11 The LORD knows human thoughts, That they are mere breath.
11 The LORD knows the thoughts of man, That they are a *mere* breath.
11 The LORD knows the thoughts of human beings— that they are futile.
11 The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity.

13 That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

14 For the LORD will not abandon His people, Nor will He abandon His inheritance.

18 If I should say, "My foot has slipped," Your faithfulness, LORD, will support me.
18 If I should say, "My foot has slipped," Your lovingkindness, O LORD, will hold me up.
18 When I say that my foot is shaking, your gracious love, LORD, will sustain me.
18 When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.

19 When my anxious thoughts multiply within me, Your comfort delights my soul.
19 When my anxious thoughts multiply within me, Your consolations delight my soul.
19 When my anxious inner thoughts become overwhelming, your comfort encourages me.
19 In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul.

20 Can a throne of destruction be allied with You, One which devises mischief by decree?

20 Will destructive national leaders, who plan wicked things through misuse of the Law, be allied with you?
20 Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law?
