Humility

1 LORD, my heart is not proud, nor my eyes arrogant; Nor do I involve myself in great matters, Or in things too difficult for me.

1 O LORD, my heart is not proud, nor my eyes haughty; Nor do I involve myself in great matters, Or in things too difficult for me.

1 LORD, my heart is not arrogant, nor do I look haughty. I do not aspire to great things, nor concern myself with things beyond my ability.

1 LORD, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me.

2 I have certainly soothed and quieted my soul; Like a weaned child resting against his mother, My soul within me is like a weaned child.

2 Surely I have composed and quieted my soul; Like a weaned child *rests* against his mother, My soul is like a weaned child within me.

2 Instead, I have composed and quieted myself like a weaned child with its mother; I am like a weaned child.

2 Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul is even as a weaned child.

3 Israel, wait for the LORD From this time on and forever.

3 O Israel, hope in the LORD From this time forth and forever.

3 Place your hope in the LORD, Israel, both now and forever.

3 Let Israel hope in the LORD from henceforth and for ever.
