A Hallelujah Psalm

1 Praise the LORD! For it is good to sing praises to our God; For it is pleasant *and* praise is beautiful.

1 Praise the LORD! For it is good to sing praises to our God; For it is pleasant *and* praise is becoming.

1 Hallelujah! It is good to sing praise to our God, and it is fitting to sing glorious praise.

1 Praise ye the LORD: for it is good to sing praises unto our God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely.

- This is yet future (the language is reminiscent of Ezek 39:28 for the return of the captives to Judah, and Neh 1:9)

-- The building of Jerusalem at the time of the regathering of Israel is the point of v2-3.

Because it is God who is rebuilding Jerusalem, it will be characterized by strength as well as peace (v12-14).

19 He declares His words to Jacob, His statutes and His judgments to Israel.

19 He declares his words to Jacob, his statutes and decrees to Israel.
19 He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel.
- God made the Mosaic Covenant exclusively with Israel, not any other nation

20 He has not dealt this way with any *other* nation; And as for His judgments, they have not known them. Praise the LORD!

20 He has not dealt with any other nation like this; they never knew his decrees.
Hallelujah!"
